The Golden Shield, 2015

Computer, Internet, paper, wood, sand

Through the looking glass of Internet censorship, this piece seeks to call awareness to the discrepancy in the information reaching the end user behind China's Golden Shield.


Through side-by-side comparison between US Google search and the Chinese equivalent, the Golden Shield is revealed as a barrier "protecting" Chinese people from ideas of dissent.

Sheng Wong (b. 1987)

Organic noise recording, binary digits, stock computer speakers

The western world's 21st century mode of gathering information (the Internet) remains persistent despite a lack of reliable information. *[UN01110000011100101100111003]/limit* creates a subtle yet increasing sense of confinement and discomfort in order to explore the auditory, physiological effects of oppression.





Audrey Shu (b. 1985)

Made in China, 2014

Wire, joss paper, acrylic, PVA, tissue paper

Apple's first iPhone debuted on the American market in 2007. It has since become an icon for innovation, style and technology. The fruit of Apple's efforts is hailed as one of the most desired pieces of American gadgetry. In fact, it is made in China. Behind the Golden Shield, the builders of these products lack the freedom and access to technology that allow their devices to work at their full potential.

Audrey Shu (b. 1985)

Made in America, 2014

Rice, American milled cotton and thread, alcohol dye

The chief exports to China from the U.S. include grains, rice, and cotton.

The American Reconnaissance Satellite USA 247 was launched in 2015; the logo depicts an octopus encircling the globe. The motto "nothing is beyond our reach" signifies that there is no hiding place for enemies of the USA.

Not even the Golden Shield can keep out the ever-vigilant eye of U.S. surveillance.





Ming Jiawei (b. 1975)

We're Ready! 2014

Digital print on vinyl

In this series we examine ideas of beauty, of power, of the ideal woman. Who is she?

To the West: the Barbie Doll. Long marketed as an example of female perfection, she is impossibly long and lean, unattainable, and hyper-sexualized. This doll, the Fashionista model, is ready for a night out on the town. She is helpless in her little dress and stiletto heels, seemingly clueless to everything, and without morals.

To the East: the People's Liberation Army action figure. She is beautiful and powerful, truly ready for anything that is asked of her. She is righteous, yet anonymous and without free will... brainwashed.

Both cultures churn out copy after copy of "perfection".

Barbie is just one of many American things made by the hands and sweat of armies of Chinese workers in order to feed the insatiable appetite of the West.



Lin Shìpín Bo (b. 1979)

I Am Not Myself, 2015

Single channel video installation

As a child, Bo's mother was obsessed with Marilyn Monroe. She would spend hours trying to make her face look just like the American pop icon. She wanted to change her hair to blonde, but Bo's father forbade it. Bo's mother believed that Marilyn Monroe possessed ideal beauty.

In changing his face to look like Marilyn Monroe Bo imagines what it would be like to have this kind of longing to look like someone else, to be someone else. Bo created the character of the Chinese policeman to tell the story of someone who lives in two worlds. He is an officer for the Chinese government and he's an artist, a performer. Who is the true person? Are any of the personas true?



Fu Zhang Lai (b. 1977) **Bra Flag,** 2014

Chinese manufactured bras mounted on fabric

Inspired by the traditions of China's Political Pop movement of the 1990's, *Bra Flag* plays with irony and absurdity by juxtaposing a powerful political symbol (the flag) with a symbol of one of China's most dominant consumer goods (the bra). *Bra Flag* gives voice to the powerless migrant laborers in the sweatshops of China whose lives are abused to create industrial goods that dominate the global market because of their low prices. *Bra Flag* is a confrontation to a capitalist system that values profit first and community last.




