

There are no earthquakes in this play, and nobody dies. But the interactions these characters have, and how they proceed through time is riveting—if you give yourself over to it.

ANNIE BAKER's plays include The Antipodes (Signature Theatre), John (National Theatre/Signature Theatre), The Flick (Playwrights Horizons/Barrow Street Theatre/National Theatre), Circle Mirror

Transformation (Playwrights Horizons), The Aliens (Rattlestick Playwrights Theater), Body Awareness (Atlantic Theater Company), and an adaptation of Chekhov's Uncle Vanya (Soho Rep), for which she also designed the costumes. Her plays have been produced at over 200 theaters throughout the U.S. and in over a dozen countries. Other honors include a MacArthur Fellowship, Guggenheim Fellowship, Steinberg Playwriting Award, American Academy of Arts and Letters Award, New York Drama Critics' Circle Award, and the Cullman Fellowship at the New York Public Library. 


